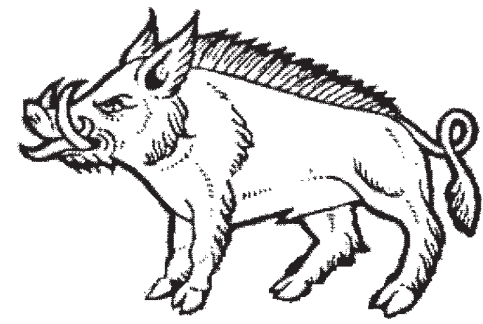


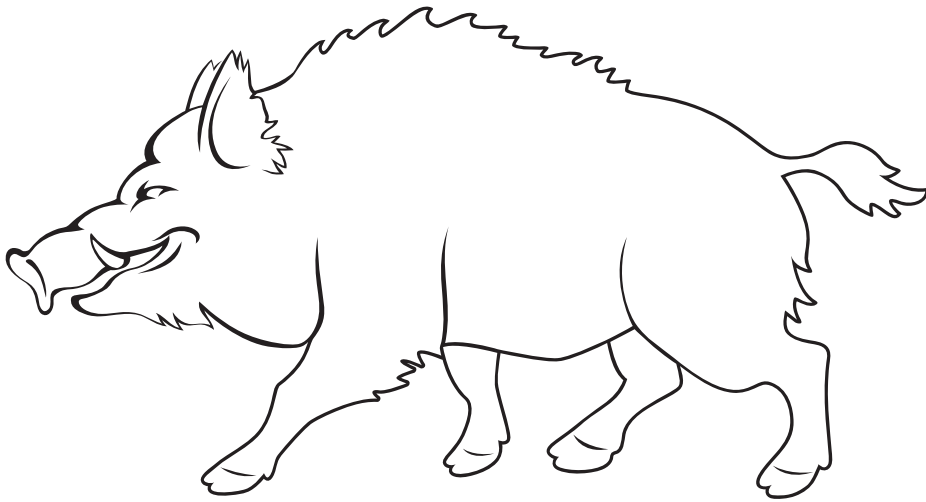
King Richard 111 white boar badge



People who supported King Richard III wore silver or gilt badges like this to show their allegiance, see how you can make one too:

You will need:

Thin card
Glue
Pencil
Scissors
Safety pin
Duct/gaffer tape
White/grey wool
Googly eyes (optional)



1. Copy the boar template on the left onto thin card and cut it out.
2. Tear off a piece of silver foil about the same size, cover your boar in glue and stick the silver foil onto the boar. Fold the edges of the foil neatly over around the edges of the boar shape.
3. Stick a googly eye on or draw an eye onto the foil with a pencil. You can draw the boar's tusk and ears on as well.
4. Stick a short piece of wool onto his rear for a tail.
5. Fix a safety pin onto the back of the boar with duct or gaffer tape.
