Richard's army was larger than Henry's with about 10,000 men compared to Henry's 5,000.

At the front of the battle stood troops led by the Duke of Norfolk - they moved forward attacking Henry's men led by the Earl of Oxford. Norfolk's men struggled and King Richard signalled for Henry Percy, Duke of Northumberland to bring his men forward to join the fight. Percy ignored the King so Richard risked everything to charge at Henry getting close enough to kill Henry's flag bearer.

At this stage the Stanley brothers, who had not yet decided who to support, made up their minds and seeing that things were going wrong for the king, chose to support the winning side - Henry's. They surrounded Richard and, knocking him from his horse, killed

him. Richard was dead and Henry was crowned, Hing Henry VII.
